Affidavit of Witness for [] Bride or [] Groom

Two witnesses for the bride and two witnesses for the groom must be interviewed using this form in order:
1 To assist in proving baptism, when certificate is unavailable.
2 To establish freedom to marry when either party is not well known to the pastor or delegate arranging the wedding.
3 To investigate the attitude of BOTH parents, when the party is under eighteen years old.
4 To investigate the stability of the marriage when either party is under eighteen years old.
5 To assist chancery officials when a dispensation/permission is being sought.
Parental testimony is always preferred and should not be neglected except for grave reasons.
